# **MUNICIPAL RESPONSIBILITIES**

**Fire Protection and Prevention Act, 1997,  
S.O. 1997, c.4 (FPPA)**

## **2. 1. Every municipality shall,**

- a) Establish a program in the municipality which must include public education with respect to fire safety and certain components of fire prevention; and**
- b) Provide such other fire protection services as it determines may be necessary in accordance with its needs and circumstances.**




# 2010 HIGHLIGHTS



Central York Fire Services, Fire Prevention Division exceeds the minimum requirements in all these areas.”









# NON-HYDRANT STREETS

# RESPONSE TYPE




# RESPONSE TIMES


- **CYFS strives to achieve a goal of:**
- **Call Processing – within 1 minute or less**
- **Turnout Time – within 1 minute or less**
- **Response Time – “driving time” within 4 min or less**
- **Total Response Time – First truck to arrive within 6 min or less 90% of the time**
- **Total Response Time to reported structures fire with a minimum of 12 Firefighters - within 10 min or less 90% of the time**
