






# EMERGENCY RESPONSE DATA










## RESPONSE TYPE



## RESPONSE TIMES

### **CYFS** strives to achieve:

Call Processing – within 1 minute or less

Turnout Time - within 1 minute or less

Response Time – "driving time" within 4 min or less

Total Response Time – First truck to arrive within 6 min or less 90% of the time

Total Response Time to reported structures fire with a minimum of 12 Firefighters - within 10 min or less 90% of the time
